

SELECTMEN'S MEETING
December 9, 2008

Selectmen in attendance: Judith L. Churchard, Robert W. Frizzell, Jason A. Cole

The meeting was opened at 6:30 pm.

Several items were addressed by the Selectmen:

- Signed a pole permit for Union School Road.
- Atkins Fund: A meeting was held with Home Health in Saco to discuss how funds are being distributed to Lebanon residents and what help is being offered. Maryanna Arsenault, President/CEO of Home Health Services said they will print a brochure advertising times for clinics, available services, etc. The Selectmen's office will be used for monthly clinics and possibly a large clinic will be held once a year at the school. Cathy Patenaude from Home Health will contact Selectperson Churchard to discuss this further.
- Metrocast Bond Change: The Selectmen signed letters of acknowledgement for the bond change to Aegis and Greenwich Insurance Companies.

Mary Ericson: Came before the Selectmen in regard to her tax bills. She requested receiving three separate bills, one for each of her houses. The Selectmen agreed this would be o.k.

Chris Gilpatrick: Came before the Selectmen with several issues:

- He feels the logging done on Hebo Hybo Rd. should have gone out to bid.
- Asked if Long Swamp Rd. where the repairs were done was hydroseeded. Selectman Frizzell responded that no, it was sprayed with a tack coat required by the State so it doesn't erode.
- Has an issue with a former town employee who was indicted and told he/she could not hold an elected position or be hired by the town, but now works for the town again.
- Chris thinks salt should be used on the parking lot of the Town Office instead of sand because eventually and being tracked in will ruin the tile floors. The Selectmen will talk to Ray Davis about this.

Selectperson Churchard made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 pm; Selectman Frizzell seconded and all were in favor.
