The Lebanon Rescue Department responded to 16 calls for service during the week of Saturday 01/16/2009 to Saturday 01/23/2010. The following is a breakdown of calls: 3 Motor Vehicle Accidents, 3 Vehicles off Road (No Injury), 2 Fall Patients, 2 Public Assists, 2 Seizure Patients, 1 Stand by at Fire Scene, 1 Hemorrhage, 1 Stroke Patient and 1 Unconscious Patient.

7 patients were transported to the hospital. 6 were transported to Frisbie Memorial Hospital and 1 to Goodall Hospital.
