Lebanon Rescue Chief's Report for Week Ending 01/16/2010



Weekly Stats:

The Lebanon Rescue Department responded to 17 calls for service during the week of Saturday 01/09/2009 to Saturday 01/16/2010. The following is a breakdown of calls: 1 Back Pain, 2 Respiratory Emergencies, 2 Cardiac Emergencies, 1 Diabetic Emergency, 2 Trauma Patients/Falls, 1 Public Assist, 1 Well Being Check, 1 Seizure Patient, 2 General Illnesses, 1 Assist Law Enforcement, 1 Stroke patient, 1 Motor Vehicle Accident and 1 Unconscious Patient.

10 Patients were transported to the hospital. 4 to Goodall Hospital, 5 to Frisbie Memorial Hospital and 1 to Wentworth Douglas Hospital.

On Thursday, Friday and Saturday of this week, we needed a second ambulance for multiple calls. In some cases, the ambulance was able to drop a patient off and then come back to town and transport the next one and the first response vehicle responded to wait for the ambulance. Mutual aid ambulance also assisted covering calls. Our responders stood by with the patients until they arrived.
