The following is a breakdown of calls: 1 Cardiac Emergencies, 1 Trauma Patients/Fall, 1 Public Assist, 1 Well Being Check, 1 Seizure Patient, 1 General Illnesses, 1 Stand by at chimney fire, 1 Assist Law Enforcement and 1 Overdose.

4 Patients were transported to the hospital. 2 to Goodall Hospital and 2 to Frisbie Memorial Hospital.
