The Lebanon Rescue Department responded to 9 calls for service during the week of Saturday 01/30/2009 to Saturday 02/06/2010. The following is a breakdown of calls: 1 Diabetic Emergency, 1 Cardiac Emergency, 1 Public Assist, 1 Medical Alarm (Fall), 1 Psychiatric Patient, 1 Seizure, 1 General Illness, 1 Respiratory Emergency and 1 Mutual Aid call to Sanford (unconscious pt).

7 Patients were transported to the hospital. 3 to Goodall Hospital and 4 to Frisbie Memorial Hospital.
