Members Present: Nancy Neubert, Judy Churchard, Glen Stadig, Paul Nadeau, Mark Stuart, Karen Gerrish, Jane Gerrish, Chris Gilpatrick, Tony Bragg.

Selectman Jason Cole was present.

Meeting called to order by Chairperson Nancy Neubert @ 6pm. Motion by Judy seconded by Jane to accept the minutes of 04/20/2010 as written.

Selectman Cole passed out the warrant for the June 8, 2010 ballot. There were no figures.

Legal Fees: Is it going out to bid? Jason said if it does it will be in June.

General Gov't: The figure will remain the same. The budget has gone down for the last 5 years. Glen said he believes the cuts should be done.

No Spray: will go down to \$10,000.00

Dispatch Fees: will go down.

Transfer Station: No change & No Cuts. Jason said the Dept. Head felt that with the 3% increase in fees he needed all that money. Chris does not agree with what goes on up there. We pay for things for Lebanon NH. The Dept. Head should be looking at all slips. Jason said Selectman Frizzell spoke to the Dept. Head about this. Large amounts of tires coming in someone should have known something wasn't right. Commercial Hauler gets a key to go in anytime he wants. Chris has inquired about this several times, still waiting for an answer. He also goes to the front of the line when he does come in and that isn't right. We shouldn't be throwing aluminum cans away when we can get money for them. The transfer station could be run more efficiently.

Rescue Enterprise Account: Some confusion about this, would like wording changed, get rid of otherwise and change to say donation, grant or Rescue revenue. Still waiting for figures on Rescue Revenue & carry over amount. The auditor is working on this.

Rescue Ordinance: would allow charging patient fees. Is the Rescue Chief appointment for life? Jason said the Selectmen could remove the chief if they needed to.

Jason said the Lawyer & Auditor would be at the public hearing to answer questions.

Fire Budget: Jason said that the mileage will be cut & the Chief will receive a stipend only. No fire fighters will be receiving mileage. The policy needs to be consistent with all departments. Rescue has never taken mileage. They let fire use their vehicles to go to training if needed.

Fire truck: 1989 FMC Pumper hopes to be sold at a good price.

EMA: took 50.00 off the phones.

Rec. Dept: will be taking the ticket money out.

Memorial Day: Chris said state law says they have to be mowed monthly. He said this should be going out to bid.

Selectmen Mileage: Is a Selectman still taking mileage to come to the office? No response.

Planning Board: Should raise fees for subdivisions.

Highways: No reduction on Budget. The problem is the quality of work. Double dipping was mentioned again. He should be supervising all work being done. Mark said if we got someone qualified, things would be better and the money would be spent better.

CEO: Reduced to 25 hours per week. He will still get his insurance. The Selectmen will be changing the personnel policy. It was mentioned about consolidating E-911 with the CEO. Jason said maybe when the present person retires they would combine it and the CEO Officer will be very busy doing illegal junkyards. They are hoping to double all the building fees.

Shore land Zoning Map: Why are we voting on this again? There was a mistake on last year's map so they had to correct it.

Discussed the conflict/incompatible office of Selectman and Transfer Station attendant. Jason said the Attorney General said that it is not a conflict.

Glen suggested that after the final budget vote that the committee has another meeting to make recommendations to the Selectmen about changes they would like to see next year.

Jason said all three Selectmen would be here Monday April 26th for the final vote.

Motion to adjourn at 8:30pm by Judy seconded by Karen and all were in favor.
